

Hours: Refuge open sunrise to sunset


Acres: 860

- Birds commonly found: Barred Owl, Great Horned Owl, Wood Duck, Northern Waterthrush, Pileated Woodpecker, Worm-eating Warbler, Ovenbird, Baltimore Oriole, Rose-breasted Grosbeak
- · Historic rock cairns dot the landscape
