



Ladybug Facts

- When flying, ladybugs can beat their wings about 85 times per second!
- A ladybug can eat 5,000 aphids in its life.
- Ladybugs are brightly colored to warn predators that they do not taste good.



Materials:

- Black and red construction paper or white paper and markers
- Body template (page 2)
- Glue stick or tape
- Scissors
- Pen or pencil
- Googly eyes (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Trace your hands on the red paper. If you are using white paper, trace and color the hands red.
- 2. Cut out the hands
- 3. Color the body template or trace it on black paper. Cut it out.
- 4. Glue the hands to the body.
- 5. Color and cut out the spots.
- 6. Glue the spots onto the hands.
- 7. Add googly eyes or draw and cut out eyes from the white paper.
