Thank you for your interest in an education program with the Audubon Society of Rhode Island. We understand that a field trip is often out of reach for many schools due to the rising cost of transportation and shrinking budgets. Thanks to the generosity of many of Audubon's supporters, we presently have the following financial opportunity available on a first come, first served basis.

If your school is participating in a program at Audubon's Environmental Education Center or one of our other wildlife refuges around the state, you are eligible for up to \$100 reimbursement to be applied towards the cost of your bus. All schools qualify for transportation grants.

Terms and conditions:

- The funding is offered on a first come first served basis.
- Programs must be scheduled during the school year (September June).
- Programs must be booked prior to applying for grant funding.
- Transportation funding may vary depending on the school/group needs.
- Transportation funding may only be used for bus transportation and cannot be applied towards program fees.
- Grant applications must be completed by the teacher/program organizer.
- You will receive confirmation for the amount of funding received within two weeks of our receiving your grant application.
- Teachers/program organizers are in charge of all scheduling and logistics with the bus company.
- A transportation invoice from the bus company MUST be submitted to Audubon's Education Department within two weeks after the scheduled program.
- Audubon will mail a check to the school for the predetermined amount only AFTER an invoice is received and the program has taken place. Checks cannot be mailed to the bus company.
