SUMMER OUTREACH PROGRAMMING



Audubon offers a range of environmental education programs for camps, libraries, day care, community centers, and other summer settings. Experienced Audubon educators can bring nature discovery, science, live animals, and tons of fun to your site for summer enrichment.

NATURE STORIES

Programs for young children include a story, activities and a live animal. Just select a topic and Audubon will do the rest! Easily done in an outdoor space, as well as the classroom.

Pre-K to Grade 2:

30 minutes, 20 children maximum, \$90 for one program, \$75 each additional on the same day.

Large Group Pre-K to Grade 2:

30 minutes, 60 children maximum, \$270. Nature Story projected on screen, activities and animal included. School must have projector, screen and laptop.

If you have children younger than 3 years old, please ask Audubon about a toddler option. For sites more than 35 miles from Providence, a \$30 travel fee per day applies. The maximum distance Audubon will travel is 50 miles one way.

SUMMER SCIENCE PROGRAMS

Audubon's one-hour science investigations are interactive, hands-on programs featuring life science topics. These programs may correlate with themes that students study in science class, but the activities are modified to engage 20-30 students in a summer setting. Many of these programs include a live animal presentation.

- Mon-Thurs 9am-5pm; Friday 9am-Noon
- For summer settings serving a range of ages, we recommend offering separate programs to ensure developmentally age-appropriate activities: 5-7 years, 8-10 years, 11-13 years.
- Fee: \$165 per one-hour program. \$135 each additional program on the same day.

- Outdoor Exploration: Choose a theme and get outside at your site! *Birds, Insects, Pollinators, or Plants & Trees.*
