AUDUBON POLLINATOR FINGER PUPPETS


As pollinators move from flower to flower, they spread the plant's pollen that is needed to form seeds. Flowers in turn provide food for pollinators in the form of nectar and pollen. Butterflies are one type of pollinator.

Materials:

- Flower and butterfly templates (included)
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- Scissors
- Tape or glue stick

Directions:

- 1. Color the flower and butterfly
- 2. Cut out the flower and butterfly including their rectangle
- 3. Tape or glue the rectangle to fit fingers
- 4. Make up a story about your puppets!
