The position will be based in the Audubon Society office in Smithfield, RI, but will travel extensively throughout the state in the course of work. A vehicle will be provided for the YCL crew and staff but transportation to a central meeting spot is required. This position will begin on July 9, 2018 and terminate on August 9, 2018. The work schedule is Monday through Thursday, 8:00 am-4:00 pm. Pay is \$10.10/hr, payable on a bi-weekly basis. It is not eligible for fringe benefits
