## **Toilet Paper Tube Frog Craft**



Materials

- Toilet paper tube
- Approximately 20 inches of yarn/string
- Leg and wing template (on this page)
- Glue
- Stapler
- Small rock/button
- 1. Color or paint the toilet paper tube, frog legs, and insect wings. Draw and color eyes on one end of the tube, or use googly eyes.
- 2. Pull the piece of yarn or string through the tube. Leave 3/4 of the yarn out of the tube, this end will become the the frog's mouth. Staple the opposite end of the tube shut, making sure the yarn is secured in place.
- 3. Cut out the legs and glue the four legs onto the frog.
- 4. Tie a small rock or button to the end of the string.
- 5. Cut out the wings.
- 6. Glue the insect wings to the rock/button.
- 7. Feed the frog! Have fun trying to toss the insect into the air and catch it in the frog's mouth.
