This 235-acre protected sanctuary of North Smithfield is a great place for a long hike through a variety of northern forest habitats at any time of year.
- 2 Powder Mill Ledges Wildlife Refuge**
12 Sanderson Road (Rt. 5), Smithfield, RI
Powder Mill Ledges, in Smithfield, is home not only to a 120-acre property graced with deep woodlands and interesting rock outcroppings, but it is also home to the Audubon Society's headquarters.
- 3 Waterman Pond**
Waterman Hill Road, Coventry, RI
Boasts 28 acres of forest with a single straight trail to tranquil Sisson Pond.
- 4 George B. Parker Woodland Wildlife Refuge**
1670 Maple Valley Road, Coventry
Parker Woodland is a magical place of ancient rock formations, Revolutionary War-era carriage roads, great wildlife watching and strenuous exercise on 860 acres of mostly forested land.
- 5 Caratunk Wildlife Refuge**
301 Brown Avenue, Seekonk, MA
With nearly 200 acres of fields, forests, streams and ponds, this is one of Audubon's most popular hiking destinations.
- 6 Long Pond Woods**
Long Pond Road, Rockville, RI
The 220 acres of rocky, steep terrain harbor dense groves of mountain laurel and rhododendron and offers arguably the most challenging hiking of any Audubon Refuge.
- 7 Fisherville Brook Wildlife Refuge**
99 Pardon Joslin Road, Exeter, RI (401) 295-8283
The Audubon Society of Rhode Island's largest property open to the public contains 1010 acres of fields, diverse forest habitats, pond streams (including a lovely waterfall), and a historic cemetery.
- 8 Davis Memorial Wildlife Refuge**
Davisville Road, North Kingstown
Refuge contains 40 acres with access for canoeing.
- 8A Narragansett Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve, Prudence Island**
- 9 Claire D. McIntosh Wildlife Refuge/ Environmental Education Center**
1401 Hope Street, Bristol
This 28-acre refuge is home to Audubon's award-winning Environmental Education Center, where educational and family programs are offered year-round.

- 11 Tousset Marsh Wildlife Refuge**
Tousset Road, Warren, RI
Easily accessible spot to visit 66 acres of hardwood forests, fields full of flowers and butterflies, and picturesque salt marsh overlooks.
- 12 Lathrop Wildlife Refuge**
Route 1A, Westerly, RI
Short and gentle trails on 86 acres lead to a popular bird watching destination, Winnapaug Pond.
- 13 Emilie Ruecker Wildlife Refuge**
Seapowet Avenue, Tiverton, RI
This refuge encompasses a breathtaking 50-acre parcel of woods and salt marsh.
- 14 Lewis-Dickens Farm**
Cooneymus Road, Block Island, RI
A bit of farming history is preserved in the 120 acres of meadows that also provide habitat for grassland birds.
- 15 Maxwell Mays Wildlife Refuge**
2082 Victory Highway (Rte 102), Coventry, RI
Contains over 295 acres of diverse wildlife habitat consisting of upland forests, wetlands, streams, ponds and open meadow.
