
## Powder Mill Ledges Wildlife Refuge

- Wildlife to watch for: red fox, grey fox, spring peeper, grey tree frog, green frog, painted turtle, white-tailed deer
- Birds commonly found: Wild Turkey, Cooper's Hawk, Barred Owl, Great Horned Owl, Eastern Screech-Owl, Pine Warbler, Black-throated Green Warbler, Ovenbird, Red-eyed Vireo, Eastern Bluebird. Tree Swallow
- · Available for birthday parties, facility rentals
- Self-guided trail stations: leaflet available at the kiosk or front desk
- Restroom facilities available Mon–Fri 9am to 5pm
