Responsibilities:

• Assist Audubon Caretaker to maintain 28 acre wildlife refuge at the Audubon Society of RI Nature Center and Aquarium in Bristol, RI including landscaping, habitat conservation, and preservation of gardens, trails, planting, cataloging plants, boardwalk, parking lot and border of property. Follow all Audubon safety guidelines and quality standards in maintenance of the gardens and grounds.

Time Commitment: 15 hours a week, flexible

- 2–4 days/week Monday-Friday
- 3 7 hours/day

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years old or older.
- Interest in conservation, gardening, wildlife, pollinators and/or botany.
- Responsible and hard working.
- Work requires physical exertion and/or physical strain and the ability to lift 35 lbs.
- Work environment may involve exposure to disagreeable elements such as summer heat.
