**Audubon's Coast Strategy: Saving Marine and Coastal Birds and the Places They Need**

Karen Hyun, Director of Water and Coastal Policy, Audubon, Washington, DC

Dr. Karen Hyun leads Audubon's efforts to advance policies at the federal and state levels in support of Audubon's Water and Coasts conservation strategies. Karen comes to Audubon after working on important conservation issues across the Executive Branch, most recently as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Fish, Wildlife and Parks at the Department of the Interior. In that role she helped ensure a successful centennial celebration for the National Park Service, increase youth engagement in the outdoors, and implement new landscape-scale approaches to conservation. She has also served in several leadership positions at the Department of Commerce and as professional staff to the House Natural Resources Committee where she focused on fisheries management and endangered species protection. Karen received her PhD in Marine Affairs at the University of Rhode Island.
