Responsibilities:

- Assist Caretaker to maintain newly installed pollinator garden at the Audubon Society of RI Nature Center and Aquarium in Bristol, RI including watering, weeding, planting and other landscaping. Position may also entail assistance in maintaining trails, additional gardens and border of property depending on interest of volunteer candidate. Follow all Audubon safety guidelines and quality standards in maintenance of the gardens and grounds.

Time Commitment:

- 1 . 3 days/week;
- 3 . 5 hours/day
- Summer/Fall

Requirements:

- Must be 16 years old or older.
- Must be able to work alone or in a group.
- Interest in gardening, pollinators and/or botany.
- Responsible and hard working.
- Work requires physical exertion and/or physical strain and the ability to lift 35 lbs.
- Work environment may involve exposure to disagreeable elements such as summer heat.
- Willingness to take direction, accept feedback and ask questions.
- Have reliable transportation to and from Bristol location.
