**GPS:** 41°40'15.5"N, 71°41'39.7"W

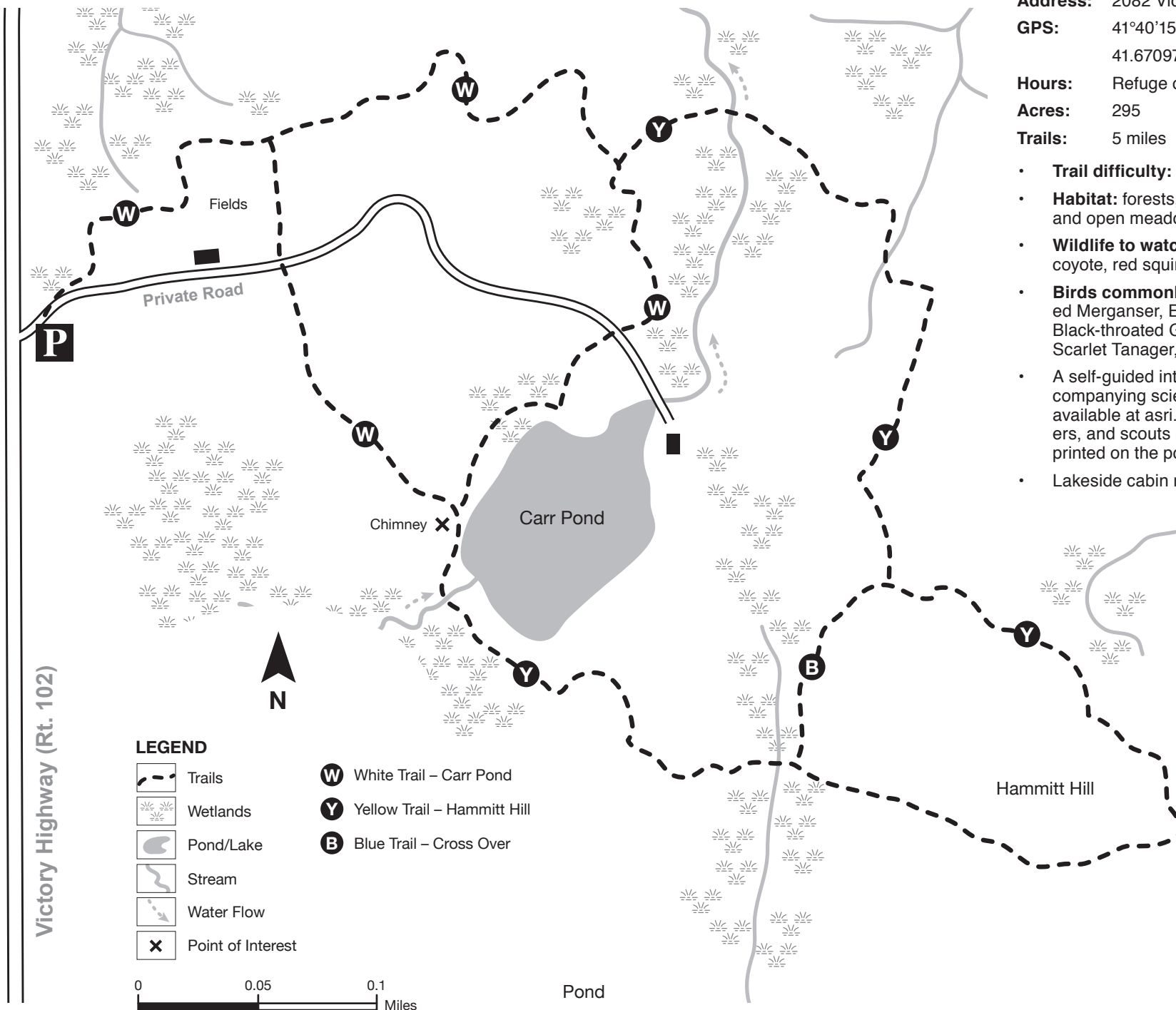

**Hours:** Refuge open sunrise to sunset

**Acres:** 295

**Trails:** 5 miles

- **Trail difficulty:** easy to moderate
- **Habitat:** forests, wetlands, streams, ponds and open meadow
- **Wildlife to watch for:** white-tailed deer, fox, coyote, red squirrel
- **Birds commonly found:** Wild Turkey, Hooded Merganser, Eastern Bluebird, Barred Owl, Black-throated Green Warbler, Ovenbird, Scarlet Tanager, Baltimore Oriole
