

SCRATCH ART CONSTELLATION

A constellation is a group of stars. When viewed from earth the group of stars make a pattern. The pattern can look like animals, people or objects. Using scratch art you can make your own constellation.





Materials:

- Blank paper
- Crayons
- Paperclip, fork or toothpick

Optional

- black tempera paint
- paint brush

Directions:

- 1. Use crayons to create a colorful design that completely covers the paper. Try not to leave any white space.
- 2. Once your design is complete, use a black crayon to color over the entire design. Your finished page should look completely black.
- 3. Use a paperclip, fork or toothpick to scratch your own constellation design through the black exposing the color underneath.

Optional:

Instead of using a black crayon, you could paint over your colorful design using a thin layer of black paint. Allow the paint to dry completely before scratching your constellation.
