

ANIMALS ON THE REFUGES

Many animals call Audubon wildlife refuges home. When you are out on the trails, you may find clues to those animals by looking for scat, fur, tracks and dens. The animals themselves might be harder to find because they may only be active at night or they may quickly hide when they hear people approaching. Audubon has put wildlife cameras out in some areas of the refuges, far away from the trails, to catch a glimpse of animals as they pass by undisturbed. Check out the photos to see who was there!
