



2022 Summer Youth Conservation League Crew

Job Description: Rhode Island Youth Conservation League (YCL) Crew members will work as a team on projects for land conservation and wildlife management partners including the Audubon Society of Rhode Island (ASRI) and The Nature Conservancy. Experience is not required but it is expected that crew members have interests in jobs in the environment, forestry, landscaping, wildlife biology, etc. Work will include controlling invasive plants, improving wildlife habitat, light carpentry such as signs and fences, native seed collection, community outreach, & more. The work will be intense & challenging, but very rewarding.



Responsibilities (*Covid-19 health and safety measures followed at all times*):

- Provide reliable personal transportation to work sites within RI and possibly Massachusetts
- Work in safe groups on a variety of land management tasks (with Covid-19 safety measures)
- Use of hand tools under direct supervision and with appropriate training
- Responsible for the maintenance and safe use of assigned tools and equipment
- Possess effective verbal and written communication skills
- Coordinate operations with YCL Leader, and Audubon Project Supervisor
- Miscellaneous other duties and responsibilities as assigned

Qualifications:

- Attention to detail and accuracy a must
- Interest in nature; Experience with outdoor work environment preferred but not mandatory
- Ability to work effectively in teams (with Covid-19 safety measures)
- Ability to multitask with efficient prioritization and time management
- Comfortable with frequent physical exertion, working outdoors on a regular basis
- Effective communicator and friendly demeanor with supervisor and coworkers

This is a fieldwork position with exposure to job hazards where there is a possibility of injury and/or arthropod-borne disease. This position requires travel throughout the state in the course of work. **Employees must be able to meet at a morning meeting spot.** This position will begin on July 5, 2022 and end on August 25, 2022. The work schedule is Monday through Thursday, 8:00 am-4:00 pm. Pay is bi-weekly, not eligible for fringe benefits.
