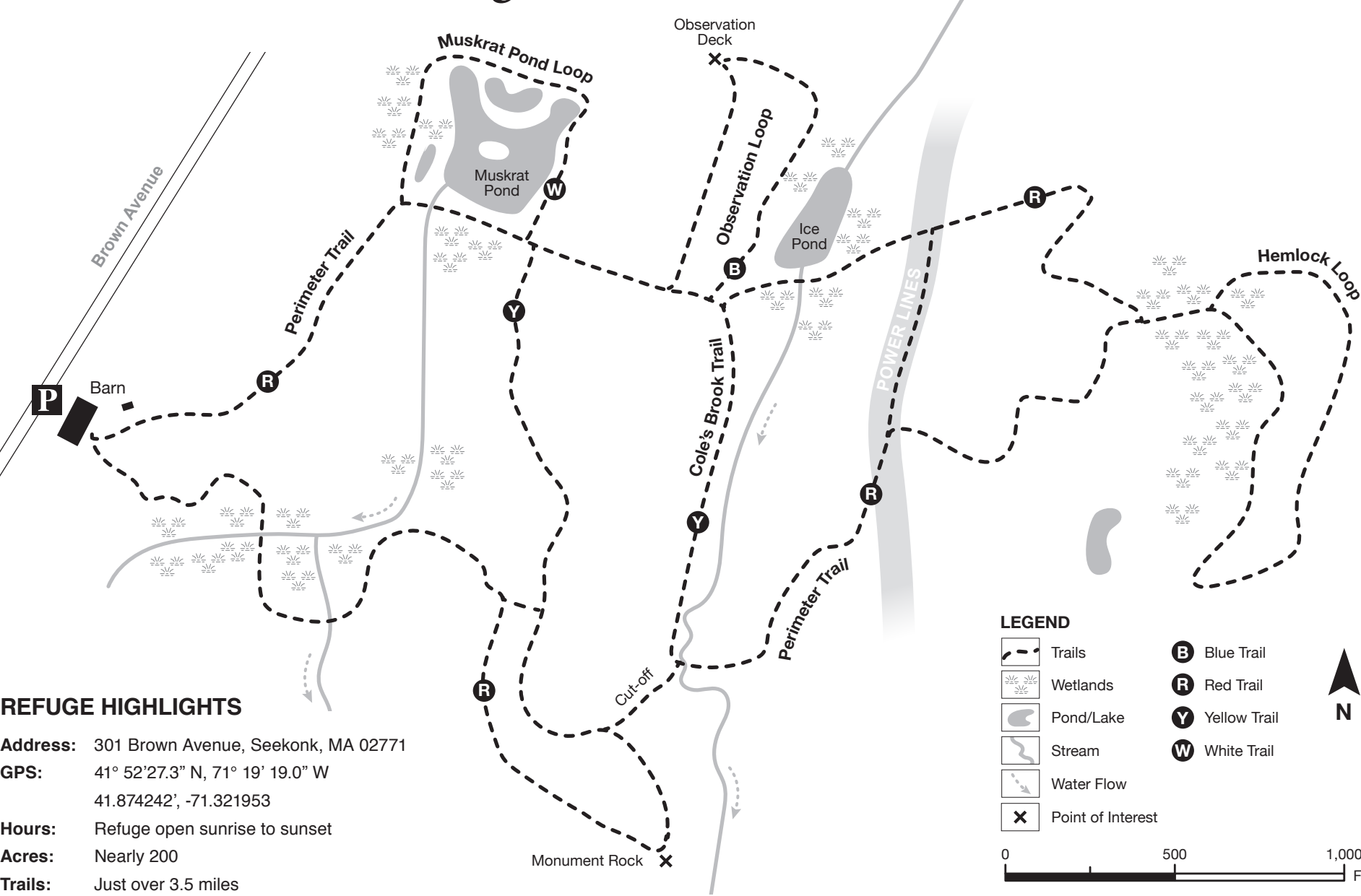


Caratunk Wildlife Refuge



REFUGE HIGHLIGHTS

Address: 301 Brown Avenue, Seekonk, MA 02771
GPS: 41° 52'27.3" N, 71° 19' 19.0" W

Hours: Refuge open sunrise to sunset
Acres: Nearly 200
Trails: Just over 3.5 miles

- **Trail difficulty:** easy to moderate
- **Habitat:** fields, forests, streams and ponds, historic white barn (open for public and private programs and events only), rain garden
- **Wildlife to watch for:** otter, muskrat, painted turtle, white-tailed deer, frog, woodchuck

- **Birds commonly found:** Eastern Bluebird, Purple Martin, Tree Swallow, American Woodcock, Scarlet Tanager, Rose-breasted Grosbeak, Baltimore Oriole, Yellow Warbler, Black-and-white Warbler, Blue-winged Warbler, Wild Turkey, Eastern Screech-Owl, Wood Duck
